
Joining other business and community leaders, the CFDC offered business recovery assistance and liaison services during the Hurricane Milton recovery efforts.



Manufacturing in Polk continues to bring impactful jobs to the area. In October, as part of **National Manufacturing Day**, the CFDC released updated stats quantifying the growing success of this strategic industry sector. Polk has attracted nearly 100 new manufacturing companies in the last five years. It's seen everything from flavors and essences to avionics, pharmaceutical and component manufacturing. The companies that established operations in the County account for 18% of the growth in this highly sought after sector. With certainly more to come.

"The future for manufacturing provides endless opportunities in Polk County and across the state," said Patricia Collins, Executive Director of Polk State's Corporate College. "Florida's manufacturing GDP (gross domestic product) has grown from \$43.5B in 2014 to \$73B in 2022, a 68% growth rate."

In 2023, manufacturing produced \$3.9B in GDP for Polk County. GDP is calculated by adding up the value of all final goods and services produced within a specific county, region or country over a specific period of time. It provides a measure of the area's economic activity as well as its health. The GDP for the region has grown 6.1% in the last 10 years compared to the national growth of 3.6%.


At the county and state levels, the labor market has begun to show signs of loosening. Unemployment increased and now sits in the full employment range of 4 - 5% for the county, while still a bit below that at the state level. Total employment sits at just under 330,000 people. The pullback in the labor markets from peak-levels should lessen cost-pressures on employers as more workers become available.

At the national level, we ended 2024 with two interest rate cuts and the Federal Reserve has signaled that they may take a more cautious approach in the new year than many investors anticipated 6 months ago. The extended period of higher interest rates may weigh on smaller businesses seeking capital while providing savers with greater returns.


From September through November 2024, according to My Florida Regional MLS, home sales were down 6.5% while median sales prices were down 3.0%, year-over-year. According to the

Census, new single-family permit requests decreased 32.9% while the average value of each permit was up 9.6%, year-over-year. Multifamily construction picked up with 660 new permits. The higher interest rates and weakening demand among buyers continues to weigh on the housing market. The lower cost multi-family housing is helping to balance out the still-high cost of construction for new housing while keeping overall housing cost relatively affordable in the county.
