Polk County Economy at a Glance

The unemployment rate in Polk County is in the normal range at 4.6%, slightly above the rate of 4.0% from August 2023. The labor market has settled a bit with employment levels dropping through the first part of the year and unemployment rising slightly as the Federal Reserve began to loosen monetary policy in the 3rd quarter. In comparison with where we stood at this point in 2019 (pre-pandemic), our Labor Force grew by 14.8%, Employment grew by 14.1% while Unemployment is up by 28.8%. Over the past 12 months, we saw job expansion in most industries, with the largest growth coming from Education and Health Services (+5.4%). We did see contraction in Information (-4.2%), however Mining, Logging and Construction (+4.3%) and Manufacturing (+2.1%) returned to job growth.
