Shift Share Analysis of Employment and Wages for Polk County

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Overview

Polk County saw significant private sector employment growth from Q1 2020 through Q1 2024, adding 26,605 jobs (13.0% growth) during the period. This is particularly strong when compared to the national growth which saw an increase of only 4.2% during the same period. The difference in growth between the nation and county accounted for just over 18,000 jobs locally. Wages have also improved overall, with 23.0% growth to an average weekly wage of \$1,082. This, however, was outpaced by the growth of wages nationally which grew by 25.4%. Overall, Polk County had strong jobs growth, with slightly underperforming wage growth, relative to the nation.

The economy has stabilized and inflation has nearly returned target levels, albeit with higher price levels. The efforts by the Federal Reserve to combat inflation have been successful so far and have avoided the "hard landing" of a recession. With monetary policy now easing and job growth remaining steady, slow price growth should give wages an opportunity to catch up over the next couple of years and return purchasing power to previous levels.

Using Shift Share Analysis, we are able to see a breakdown of what sectors and subsectors were responsible for the job growth, above and beyond what would have been expected. The growth can be broken down into 3 components:

- 1. The National Component how many jobs would have been created if, at the county level, the sector grew at the overall national average (4.0% in the study period).
- 2. The Industry Component the difference in job creation between the overall national average and the sector, at the national average.
- 3. The Local Component the difference in job creation between the actual local employment change and what would have been expected given the overall national and industry growth.

To see how Polk County has fared, it is important to separate out the Local Component from the overall job growth. This was studied down to the 3-digit NAICS subsector level.

At the 2-digit level, we saw strong local growth from:

- Transportation and Warehousing (36.3%)
- Real Estate and Rental and Leasing (22.0%)
- Educational Services (17.0%)
- Administrative and Waste Services (16.0%)
- Health Care and Social Assistance (15.1%)

We saw moderate growth from:

- Information (12.9%)
- Construction (12.7%)
- Other Service, Except Public Administration (12.1%)
- Accommodation and Food Services (11.0%)
- Retail Trade (9.9%)
- Finance and Insurance (8.2%)
- Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services (7.5%)
- Manufacturing (7.3%)

We saw low to negative growth from:

- Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation (3.9%)
- Wholesale Trade (3.4%)
- Management of Companies and Enterprises (2.3%)
- Utilities (-3.1%)
- Mining, Quarrying, and Oil and Gas Extraction (-6.3%)
- Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing and Hunting (-28.9%)

There can be much variation among the 3-digit subsectors within each sector¹. Analyzing this data may shed light on where the growth came from and how the growth in some areas compares to the losses in others. It is also worth considering the impact to the local economy of the jobs gained and lost. Two measures we can look at are Location Quotient (LQ) and average wages. LQs greater than 1 represent industries that have basic jobs for the Polk County economy, where basic jobs are ones above and beyond those necessary to meet the average demand for goods from that subsector given the population of the county. In other words, the basic jobs are the ones that produce the goods and services we "export" outside of the county, bringing outside money in. High LQ subsectors provide significant economic benefit to our county by bringing that outside money in. It is also worthwhile to study the changes to average wages in the subsectors. To do this, we can also conduct a Shift Share Analysis on the wages at the subsector level.

¹ Several of the 6-digit NAICS codes were redefined in 2022 leading to an imperfect, but close comparison between 2020 data and 2024 data.

Industry Summaries

Agriculture

Within Agriculture, the most significant losses come from Crop Production, which lost 426 jobs in Polk County. This has a somewhat mitigated impact due to the lower-than-average wages (\$769 weekly). Wages for the sector as a whole were up significantly (+27.4%) with an overperformance locally (local component of +7.8%).

Mining, Quarrying, and Oil and Gas Extraction

There were 667 jobs in Mining, Quarrying, and Oil and Gas Extraction, down 45 from 2020. These jobs

are less impactful with a LQ of .66, however they have wages of \$2,047 per week.


Utilities

Within Utilities there were job losses (-3.1% overall, 10.7% less than at the national level), with wages falling behind national growth for the industry by 3.7%. Despite the relatively small size of the private Utility sector, these jobs are among our highest wage jobs with weekly wages of \$2,838. A return to growth here would create a meaningful economic impact.

Construction

The time-period under review saw a significant uptick in construction activity as building activity picked up with significant demand throughout 2021 and 2022, with things slowing a bit more in 2023 and early 2024. Overall, construction jobs were up 12.7%, with local growth stronger than national industrial growth by 4.9%. Wages for the industry locally are up as well (+29.9%) with Polk County outperforming the national industry averages (+7.5%). The Construction industry's wage growth is meaningful as it pushed the average industries wage above the county average wage.





Manufacturing

In Manufacturing, Polk County grew while jobs remained nearly flat nationally (+7.3% in the county, 0.5% nationally, for a local factor of +6.8%,). There is, however, meaningful variation within the sector. The largest growth came from Nonmetallic Mineral Production Manufacturing and Food Manufacturing which added 410 and 380 jobs, respectively. Nonmetallic Mineral Production Manufacturing pays above average wages (\$1,466 weekly) with a LQ of 3.2 while Food Manufacturing pays an average wage (\$1,244 weekly) with a LQ of 2.5. Both subsectors provide Basic Jobs and have a wage above the county's average.

Wholesale Trade


Wholesale Trade employment grew by 3.4%, slightly underperforming national growth with a local growth component of -0.6%. The additional jobs came from Merchant Wholesalers, Durable Goods, which added 718 jobs while the Nondurable Goods subsector lost 432 jobs. Wholesale Trade jobs carried an average wage of \$1,702 per week.

Retail Trade

Within the Retail Trade sector, there was significant variation among 3-digit classifications. It should also be noted that the NAICS classification system made changes to some of the classifications for 2022, so while current jobs are considered accurate the changes at the 3-digit level are only approximations. Overall, Retail Trade grew by 9.9%, adding 2,872 jobs, while jobs were effectively flat nationally in the industry, leading to a local component of +9.8%. Among Retail Trade, the only subsector with above average wages is the Motor Vehicle and Parts Dealers (\$1,195 weekly), however, they experienced a wage decline locally (-2.4%).

Transportation and Warehousing

Job growth for Transportation and Warehousing outpaced the national industrial average by a wide margin (local component of +22.0%) and was responsible for over 7,500 new jobs since 2020. Warehousing and Storage jobs outperformed national industrial growth (local component of 15.1%) and added just over 6,600 jobs overall. Warehousing and Storage continues to bolster the county's strong position in the industry with an LQ of 5.9. The next largest contribution from that industry was from Truck Transportation, which added nearly 600 jobs



with a local growth component of 8.9%. These jobs are particularly important as the Truck Transportation weekly wages (\$1,287) are above the county average.

Information

The Information sector added 232 jobs, outpacing the the national average (+12.1% local component), with much of the growth coming from the Telecommunications subsector which added 179 jobs. With a LQ of 1.1 and above average wage (\$1,237 weekly), Telecommunications is of growing importance to the county.

Finance and Insurance

The net job gain in Finance and Insurance was solid (+8.2%, for nearly 800 jobs) and outpaced the national average with a positive local component (+4.8%). The growth was driven mainly by Insurance Carriers and Related Activities, where 455 new jobs were added. The gains in insurance are more impactful with a LQ of 1.5 with above average wages (\$1,503 weekly). Wage growth in the sector lagged the national trend with local component of -8.5% and overall growth of 14.4% to an average of \$1,767 per week. While wages in Finance have not kept up with national growth, it remains one of the county's highest paying industries.

Real Estate and Rental and Leasing

Real Estate and Rental and Leasing outperformed the national industrial employment growth (local component +22.0%), supported by growth at the Real Estate subsector level (local growth component +18.4%). This is of relatively low impact as the LQ is below 1 and the average weekly wages (\$828) are below the county average.

Professional, Scientific and Technical Services

Professional and Technical Services underperformed the national industrial employment growth pace (local component -3.3%) but remains a low impact portion of the economy with a LQ of 0.5, however the wages (\$1,359 weekly) are above county averages.

Management of Companies and Enterprises

Management of Companies and Enterprises underperformed the national industrial employment growth (local component -5.7%). This has a meaningful impact on the local economy as it remains a high impact (LQ 1.5) and high wage (\$1,863 weekly) industry for the county.

Administrative and Waste Services

Locally, Administrative and Waste Services outpaced national industrial employment averages (local component +16.5%). The impact of this sector is increasing as the LQ remains above 1.0, however, the wages (\$846) are below county averages.

Educational Services

Employment growth in Educational Services outpaced national industrial averages (local component +9.8%), while wages grew more slowly (-2.9%) as compared to wage changes around the nation.

Health Care and Social Assistance

Employment growth in Nursing and Residential Care Facilities outpaced national industrial averages (local component of +8.3%), adding over 4,500 jobs. We also had relative growth in Ambulatory Health Care Services, and Hospitals (local components of +11.0%, and 10.7%, respectively). The gains from both Ambulatory Health Care Services and Hospitals are impactful as these jobs carry higher wages (\$1,345 and \$1,285, respectively) and LQ of 1.4 and 1.2, respectively. Wage growth in the Ambulatory Health Care Services, however, is lagging national growth (-10.5% local component) as compared to national industrial averages.


Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation

The industry gained jobs overall (+3.9%, for 164 jobs), however, it underperformed as compared to national industrial averages (local component of -0.9%). While none of the subsectors lost jobs, Performing Arts, Spectator Sports, and Related Industries and Amusements, Gambling and Recreation both underperformed national industrial averages. Wages in the Performing Arts, Spectator Sports, and Related Industries subsector fell substantially (-16.8%) despite national industrial average wages increasing 30.4%, they remain above county average wages.

Accommodation and Food Services

Accommodation and Food Services were in recovery mode, gaining 2,229 jobs overall and outperforming the national recovery (local component of +10.6%, overall gain of 11.0%). Overall wage growth in the subsector was positive and outpaced national wage growth (local component of +5.3%). The county remains underserved by Accommodations (LQ of 0.6) and gave back prior gains as it had grown to an LQ of 0.8 last year.

Other Services, Except Public Administration



Employment in Other Services, Except Public Administration outpaced national industrial averages (local component of +9.7%), with meaningful gains coming from all subsectors except the Private Household subsector (-20 job losses overall). The gains in the Repair and Maintenance subsector (330 jobs) are also impactful with an LQ of 1.3 and wages above the county average (\$1,177 weekly).
